Description of Project

Social services offered currently by the various organizations responsible for the sector need to be reframed in order to meet the new demands shaped by the changing social picture. This survey is aimed at providing data to help design social services that are fit-for-purpose and future-proof, based on needs expressed by young people, who are the future users.

The activities will include peer visits aimed at defining the themes and the outcomes of the survey so far carried out in the Italian areas; to understand the strengths and weaknesses of the survey so far and to adapt the survey tool (questionnaire) to the UK socio-emotional environment. This is a very important stage, in order to make sure that the survey provides comparable outcomes, by not only providing a linguistic translation of the questionnaire from Italian into English, but also to make the questions fit the 'emotional understanding' of the UK sample.

The pilot study will also provide the methodological guidelines for extending the survey to other European member regions.

The expected outcome is to make available to stakeholders within the European Union and within the two member regions involved the data provided by the pilot survey, in order to improve micro and macro decision and policy making.
